Good afternoon everyone and welcome to Bolitho Park for our first ever game in the step 5 Western League, a new, exciting challenge for all of us. We welcome in particular today the officials, management, players and supporters of Odd Down (Bath).

Winning the SW Peninsula League last season was a fantastic achievement and hopefully the first step on the journey to meet the aims and ambitions of the club. It was a superb effort by everyone at the club both on and off the pitch and they can all be very proud of their efforts. Competing in the Western league for the first time is a step into the unknown for most of us but rest assured we are all up for the challenges ahead and will be looking to finish as high as we can in the league. It is worth noting that last season's champions Street dropped 15 points on their way to the title and the runners up Melksham dropped 30. Both have been promoted. This would indicate that the league is very competitive and anyone can beat anyone on the day and there will be no easy games. We have managed to have a couple of our early season opponents watched and I understand we may have been watched too!

I'm pleased to report that an awful lot of work has gone in during the close season in putting a balanced, competitive squad together and that the hard work has paid off with all but 3 of last season's squad re-signing. Glyn Hobbs, Luke Durham and Charlie Johansen have decided to move on and we thank them for their past efforts and wish them well for the future. I have managed to add 5 new players to the

squad making a current total of 17. There may be a couple more additions. Vastly experienced striker Stewart Yetton has signed from Truro City. Stewart has played for Plymouth Argyle, Tiverton, Weymouth and Truro for many years and his knowledge and experience at the higher level should prove invaluable. Fellow striker Adam Carter, who should need no introduction to most of you, has been around the SWPL circuit for some years and is currently the

SWPL leading scorer of all time. Teigan Rosenquest joins us from last season's runners up Tavistock. Teigan is a useful utility player and can play on either flank or at full back. Promising young midfielder Jack Rhead has been promoted from last season's reserves and looks to have a bright future. Finally young goalkeeper Neil Osborn comes to us highly recommended having spent time on the books of Torquay United and Southampton. I am confident the new signings will augment the already strong squad and provide competition for places throughout the side.

Much has been said about the amount of travel involved in the league. One of our supporters has produced a chart of travel distances/times which totals 4,180 miles to/from the 19 away league games resulting in around 72 hours travel time (3 days!). The vast majority of away trips in the league are currently planned for Saturdays with the only midweek fixtures being at Willand Rovers next Wednesday and Shepton Mallet on Easter Monday. The Boxing Day/Good Friday local derby games will be with Buckland Athletic. These fixtures will obviously be subject to change dependent on our progress in the FA Cup and FA Vase and of course the vagaries of the English weather. The Les Phillips Cup (the league cup) fixtures are always programmed to be midweek and we visit Bitton on Tuesday 25 Sep in the first round. On the subject of the national competitions, we will be looking to progress as far as possible in both, with the FA Cup prize money being substantially increased this season.

Pre-season has gone reasonably well with a mixed bag of performances and results.

Not all the players were available for all the games which gave me the opportunity to rotate the squad, work on formations and get the players gelling, building partnerships and understanding each other's games. Fitness levels have gradually improved and we have come through with no major injuries. Although I am never too concerned about pre-season results, I was particularly pleased with our performance and 4-0 victory at Bristol Manor Farm against a good side from a step 4 league. Whilst it was disappointing to lose 2-1 to Falmouth Town in the SWPL Charity Bowl last Sunday, I felt we played well enough to win the game playing with 10 men for the best part of an hour and had we taken just some of our many chances and cut out our defensive errors, could well have done so. Unfortunately Nick Milton was sent off in the first half and will now miss 3 games.

Karl, myself and the players are all looking forward to testing ourselves at a higher level and visiting new grounds in what should be an exciting season in which we are hoping to do well.

The support home and away last season was very much appreciated by us all and we look forward to that continuing this season despite the extra travel involved to away games. A coach has been arranged for the players and staff with spare capacity available for supporters. For full details please see either the Chairman or a member of the committee.



In the early part of 2012-2013 season, work commitments led to Lee Burns stepping down as manager, however his then assistant manager Terry Moore took up the reign and in 2013 – 2014 season with Ray Johnston as his assistant steered Odd Down FC to fourth place in the Premier League.

2014-2015 season saw the resignation of Terry Moore, but Ray Johnston was ready to step up to the challenge and appointed Lee Rendell as his assistant. Ray and Lee proved to be a winning partnership and in their first season in management roles achieved 5th spot in Toolstation Western League Premier Division.

2015 – 2016 has seen Ray retain all but one member of last season's squad, and with a successful preseason campaign behind them the coming season looks promising for Ray, Lee and their squad.

What a season 2015 -2016 turned out to be for the club, Over the closed season a mixture of 1st Team, Reserve Team and U18s players secured the title in the Fry Club Tournament which gave them a good preseason workout and set the scene for the coming season culminating in Odd Down being crowned the Western League Champions for the first time in the club's history,

2016 – 2017 With Ray Johnston and Lee Rendall still at the helm, it wasn't such a good season however the 1st team and reserves both finished 7th in their respective leagues, with the U18s taking runners up spot for the second successive season.

The crowning of Odd Down Reserves as Somerset FA Senior Cup Champions was to a terrific end to the season.

2017-2018 The team of Ray and Lee continue with the first team again for this season, Jason Maggs has a new side kick in Richard Griffith well known around the local football scene, and Stewart Bradley & Shaun Wiles- Richards have taken over the reins for the U18s team. Jason Maggs resigned early into the current season and Rich Griffiths (Griff) stepped up to the plate with assistance from Dave Cooper and Terry Wade, in November Ray Johnson decided to leave the club to concentrate on his new home, leaving Lee Rendall to take over the reins of the 1st Team, Lee lost no time in recruiting Dean Horseman from Thornbury Town as his No2. The U18s had a great season North Division Winners with promotion to the premier Division and League Cup runners up. The 1st team finished 14th in their league with the Reserves a credible 9th in theirs, so the coming 18-19 season should only get better for all 3 teams.
